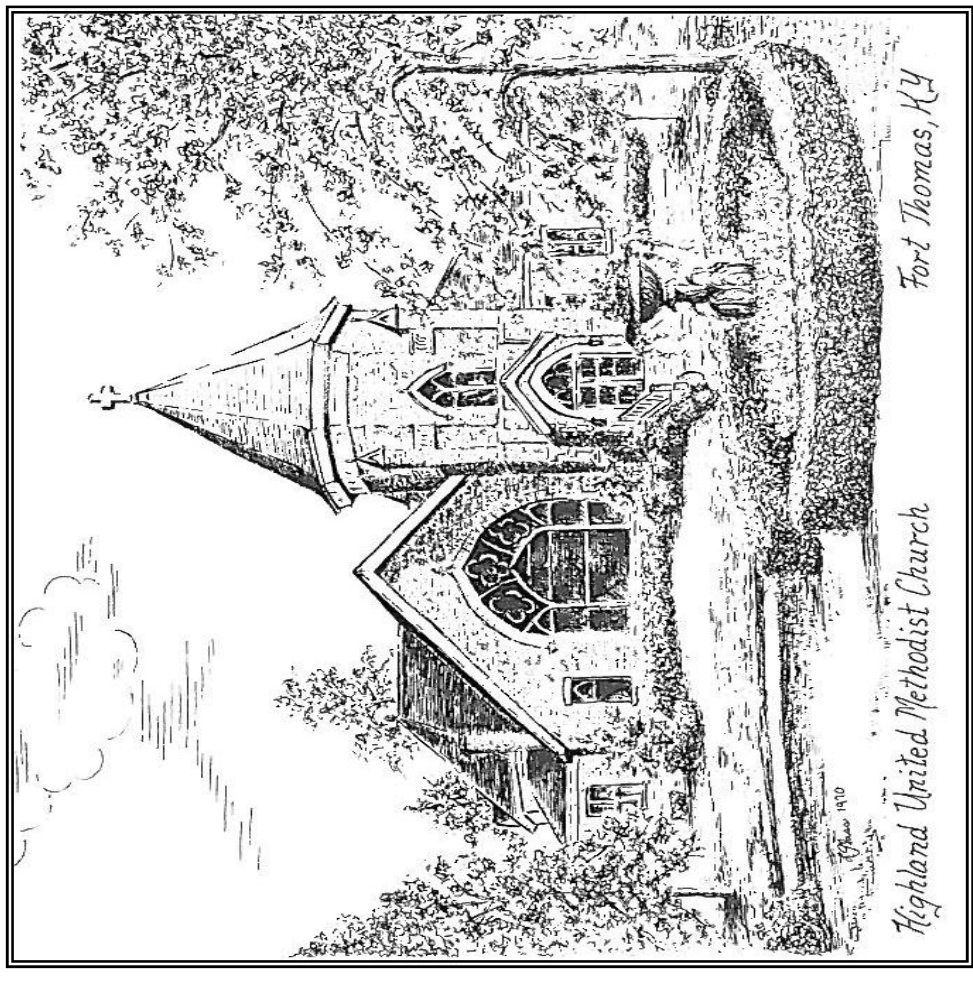

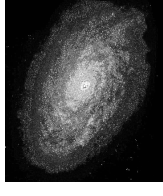
ALTAR FLOWERS

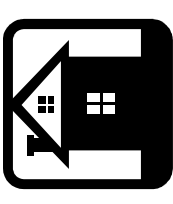
