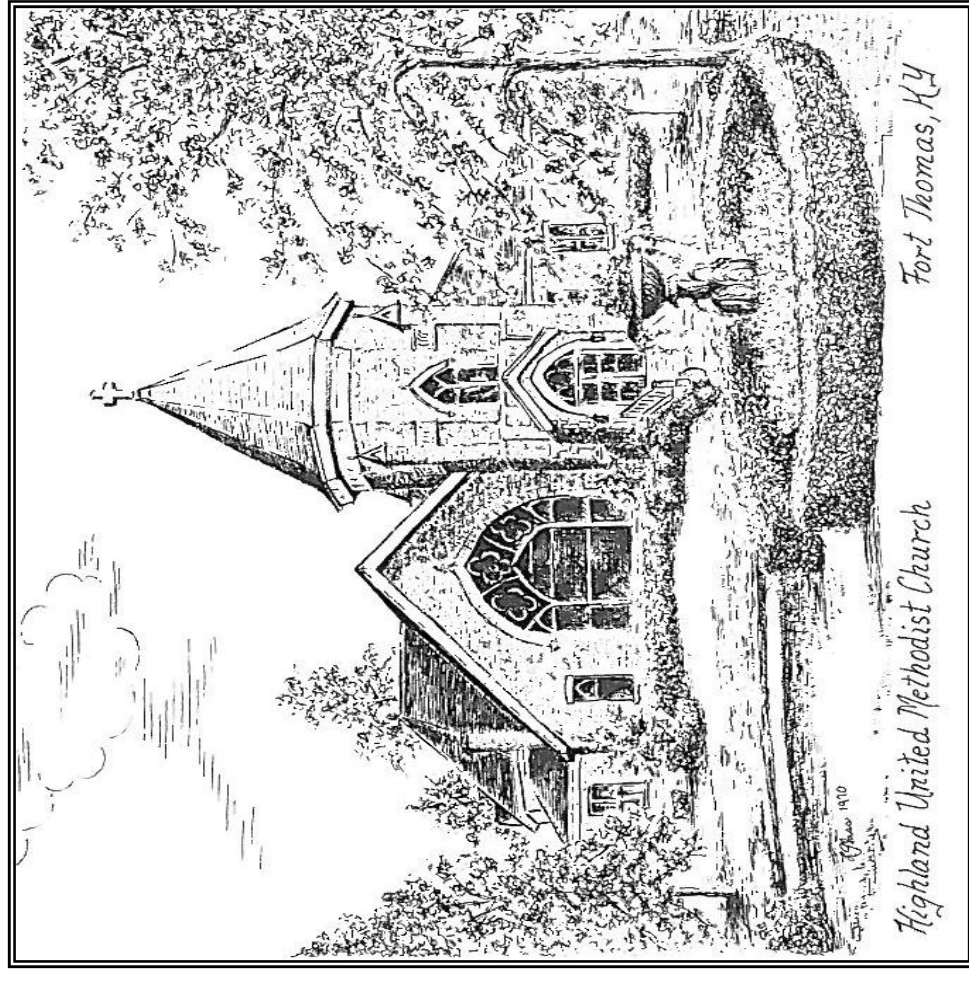

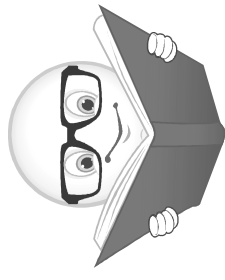

SUMMER READING LEADER

This summer, we are going to be providing "reading clubs" for our Junior and Senior High. Each summer, those that attend Highlands high school or middle school are required to read a book over the summer which they will be required to answer questions about the book when they return in the fall. It is always more fun (and often more effective) if we can do this together!

So, we are going to create six reading clubs this summer (one for each grade). The purpose will be to work together toward understanding the book and answering the questions the school will ask; in addition, we are going to look at the book from a Christian world view. We will discuss such questions as "how is this character exhibiting Christian character? How would we, as Christians, handle this situation differently?". We need volunteers who will take one of the grades and be committed to leading the book study for that grade. We will meet weekly for 6 or 7 weeks during the summer (schedule flexible).
